The Thomas Erkelens Scholarship Fund is for those enrolled or are enrolling in the ISA UT-Chapter/ UCFC Arborist Apprenticeship Program. This scholarship is intended to help with tuition of the two year program with six semesters. The scholarship recipient is responsible to pay for half of each semester and the Scholarship Fund will fund the other half. The recipient must complete all four classes in each semester to receive the fund. If a class is missed, the scholarship will be reduced by the cost of the class for that semester.

The value of scholarships awarded is determined by the amount the UCFC has in the Thomas Erkelens Scholarship Fund.

Through donations, we are able to offer a Thomas Erkelens Scholarship to those who need financial assistance to attend the Arborist Apprenticeship Program. Scholarships are reviewed by the UCFC Membership Committee.

- At least two letters from employer, friend, mentor of why applicant would be a candidate to receive a scholarship and things applicant has done to deserve to be selected.
- Limited funds are available. Scholarships can be awarded in various amounts.
- You will be notified via email whether an award was made for the applicant.
- It is required that scholarship recipients assist through 20 combined service hours working on a UCFC Committee, helping at the UCFC Tree Climb, or help at a UCFC Workshop.
- This scholarship is awarded without regard to race, color, national origin, age, sex, or handicap status.
